WHAT NEEDS TO HAPPEN FOR ANDALUSIA TO ADVANCE?

1. Vigor must defeat Williamson. (A win for Williamson would add 8 points to their calculation).

Plus 1 of these four things:

- 1. Opp must defeat Luverne; or
- 2. Trinity must defeat St. James; or

Possible Scenarios:

- 1. If Andalusia beats Williamson in this calculation, Andalusia is the No. 3 seed, and Williamson would be the No. 4 seed.
- 2. If Andalusia ties Williamson in this calculation, based on head-to-head, Andalusia would be

- 3. Selma must defeat LeFlore; or
- 4. Gulf Shores must defeat B.C. Rain

No. 3 seed and Williamson would be No. 4 seed, based on head-to-head with Escambia County.

3. If Williamson is the No. 3 seed, the No. 4 seed would be decided by head-to-head, and Escambia County would be the No. 4 seed.
